Four new models to be launched in mid-October 2023

TOMY Company, Ltd. will release "ULTRAMAN TOMICA" with a design inspired by Ultra Heroes from the ULTRAMAN series, as new models of die-cast miniature car "TOMICA," in the Asian region excluding Japan, namely: China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines and Vietnam.

The first four models, "UTR-01 ULTRAMAN TIGA MULTI TYPE", "UTR-02 ULTRAMAN ZERO", "UTR-03 ULTRAMAN BLAZAR" and "UTR-04 ULTRAMAN GEED PRIMITIVE" will be released in mid-October 2023.

The first four models of "ULTRAMAN TOMICA" are designed after the characters "Ultraman Tiga Multi Type", "Ultraman Zero", "Ultraman Blazar" and "Ultraman Geed Primitive" from the ULTRAMAN series. Above all, the faces of the ULTRAMAN characters are designed on the "hood" of "TOMICA" vehicles and the Color Timers of the ULTRAMAN characters are designed on the "roof" of "TOMICA" vehicles. The TOMICA vehicles are selected to take advantage of the design features.

"TOMICA" was launched in 1970 as Japan's first series of Japanese palm-sized diecast miniature cars. In those days when foreign-made miniature cars were at the height of their popularity, the product was born out of a passionate desire to "let Japanese children play with more familiar domestic miniature cars" and today they are loved by parents and children for three generations. To date, more than 1,140 different types of vehicles have been launched, with the total sales exceeding 725 million units (as of April 2023).
